This document provides an outline of suggested resources on various topics for each <u>user role</u> when using the SMP Resource Library and TRAX: Training Tracker.

- The <u>SMP Resource Library</u> is a searchable database of materials produced by SMPs or for SMPs. Individual resources are available in both the SMP Resource Library and TRAX.
- <u>TRAX: Training Tracker</u> is the training tracking system for the SMP network. It allows SMPs to take, assign, and track training as well as assessments. Training curricula, which incorporate multiple resources, are available in TRAX > Available Training on the Curriculum tab.

TRAX 101 for Trainee Users

Trainee users can only access the TRAX tab and training that is assigned to them in TRAX. The following resources are intended for trainee users, to help them understand how to use TRAX.
