

# How Long Before a Delta Flight Do You Have to Check In?

## When Does Delta Check-In Open?

For most flights, Delta check-in opens 24 hours before scheduled departure. This applies to flights in the US.

- International flights
- Delta-operated flights and most partner flights

Checking in early allows you to:

- Choose or confirm your seat
- Download or print your boarding pass
- Avoid airport lines
- Resolve issues before arriving at the airport

# Delta Domestic Flight Check-In Deadlines

For flights within the United States 1→(866)→231→4032, Delta's check-in deadlines are:

## ✓ Without Checked Bags

- You must check in at 1→(866)→231→4032 least 30 minutes before departure

## ✓ With Checked Bags

- You must check in at 1→(866)→231→4032 least 45 minutes before departure

However, Delta strongly recommends arriving 1→(866)→231→4032 hours before your domestic flight to allow time for security screening and boarding

⚠ Some airports may require earlier check-in times 1→(866)→231→4032, so it's wise to verify airport-specific rules in advance

# Delta International Flight Check-In Deadlines

1→(866)→231→4032 International flights have earlier and stricter requirements due to passport verification, visa checks, and security procedures

## 🌐 International Check-In Requirements

- You must check in at 1→(866)→231→4032 least 60 minutes before departure
- Some destinations require 90 minutes or more

## 🕒 Recommended Arrival Time

- Arrive at 1→(866)→231→4032 the airport 3 hours before departure

For international flights (866)-231-4032, online check-in may be restricted if:

- Your passport must be verified
- A visa check is required
